

The venue for the 26/27 Relight Creative Supervision Training will be at **The Nest**, a bright, private space adjacent to the Bean Tree Cafe, located in Page Park, Staple Hill, Bristol. The space is suitable to conduct the training with soundproofing and with views of the park, it has a small kitchenette and private entrance. Along with the cafe, it is **disability accessible and includes accessible toilets**. Please note the weekend of 17th and 18th of October 2026 is likely to be in an alternative venue (to be confirmed).

We also have the park to use during the training.



## Location & Access:

Page Park is located in Staple Hill, South Gloucestershire. It is roughly 5 miles north east of the centre of Bristol. The Nest is located next to the sensory garden area of the park, with wild flowers and potted plants to view (and is a dog free zone) and homes a famous bird cage. There are two play areas, tennis courts and lots of flat open paths to walk. The park houses lots of community activities such as park runs, sporting events and community gatherings.

The park is enclosed by Broad Street, Hill House Road, Park Road and South View and can be easily accessed by car, on foot or by bike or bus and is just 400m from the Bristol to Bath cycle path which exits onto Signal Road.

All gated entrances are wide enough to allow for wheelchair access. All of the paths around the park are flat and in good condition. There is parking along the side roads around the park and disabled car parking spaces are available on all sides of the park.
